

Calling all health practitioners... you are invited to a webinar discussing GDM and how to refer to the Living Well Taking Control (LWTC) service provider for the National Diabetes Prevention Programme (NDPP)/GDM.

Why Prevention Matters? Women who have previously been diagnosed with Gestational Diabetes are at higher risk than the general population of developing Type 2 Diabetes.

The NDPP provided by Living Well Taking Control gives support needed to help manage health and prevent the onset of Type 2 Diabetes and Gestational Diabetes in future pregnancies.

This session will cover prevention of Type 2 Diabetes and Gestational Diabetes in pregnancy. It will also provide the opportunity to understand the eligibility criteria, how to refer patients, including information on:-

✓ What has changed?

✓ Will there be any changes to referrals from General Practice?

✓ Why has the change been made?

✓ How will the GDM selfreferral pathway work?
